NEW BUSINESS:

Holiday Donation Decision – Karol opened the subject up for discussion and a motion. It was decided that there is a need to focus on helping kids and Stand Up For Kids will be the recipient this year. A motion was made, seconded and approved. Stand Up For Kids has been one of our Fest vendors for several years and comes highly recommended by several professionals in the area.

Fest Events – Karol – Flo and Karol have discussed what to do this next year for the Fest and right now there isn't enough information to make a solid decision. However, there are some things that can be done in case we decide that a simple version can be done.

Gene Warden will talk to the museum around March and see where they're at with reopening. Around May 1st he will contact the base to have them pencil in a date. It's possible that even as late as August we could still pull things together like a car show and some food trucks without investing a lot of funds or volunteers. This timeframe gives us time to see where things are at with the vaccine.

Most of the money from our funds will go to the Central Park Projects when the insurance coverage is resolved, leaving little money for the Fest. There will also be the cost of insurance in May.
