Meeting called to order at 7:03 pm

May Meeting Minute Approval – MSP to approve May meeting as presented

Treasurer's Report and Treasury Audit Report – This information is available at the KIC meeting or by contacting KIC Treasurer, Jason Ward.

Port of Keyport Update – Commissioner Warden reported as of last night Port received approval increasing the line of credit \$100K to assist with phase 2 phase of work which will start August at the earliest. Port also approved contract with Redside construction who replaced launch ramp for phase 2 work. The timber decking will be removed and be available to interested residents when work is completed. Committee Reports:

Park Committee Update - We have cleaned up Central Park with over 20 volunteers and spent \$4557.00 to remove the hedge, put up a fence, and lay down some beauty bark. It will be another approximate \$3500 to put in a sprinkler system if we get permission and want to spend that kind of money. Thank you to the 20 volunteers.

Fest Decision – It was decided not to have the Fest this year. The Health Department recommended not to have kids' activities at this time and be flexible. Instead, we will have a **9/18 Keyport Rendezvous and Community Garage Sale** - We will have a Show and Shine car show from noon – 4 pm on the day we normally hold Keyport Fest. We will also have the community garage sale as the church is not having their normal sale in June. Please start collecting items and we will inform you for a location to store things.. Claire Ward will be designing a t-shirt for the event and we will also have a 50/50 raffle and basket raffle.

4th of July Activities –The parade will begin at 1 pm. We are looking at possibly having other activities before and after the parade and will post flyers with information.

August Potluck Picnic date – Saturday, August 14 – Noon at Central Park. Bring something to share and silverware for your party.

KIC Insurance Status – We are continuing our current liability coverage and are still working out agreements with the county regarding Central Park.

Fiber Optics Survey Status – Survey sent out via Mailchimp. Approx. 25 responses have been received. Everyone is encouraged to complete the short survey which doesn't obligate anyone. The deadline is June 30 and two more reminders will be sent out.
