Officer Election: A motion was made and passed to elect Peg Garrison as the new VP. Thank you Peg!

Park Committee – Doug Chamberlain – The club financed the installation of the fence where the hedge was at Central Park.

Thank you to Deborah DuBois for her ongoing work on the parks and the county trench by Ben's.

Milt Meeds will take over the Central Park holiday tree decoration duty this year.

Doug is working on the annual request letter to the county. If you have any ideas to submit, please let Doug know.

Emergency Preparedness – Karol S. – Inventory of the bags in the sheds will be done soon. Judy Kelly and Rosie W. volunteered to help.

Broadband Fiber Optics Survey – Claire W. – 35 households participated in the survey which was submitted to KPUD. The estimate they provided was a high level of \$7000.00 per house to bring in service to town and each home. Claire is looking into the possibility of a public entity, such as the Port or the PO, getting a grant to bring broadband to their facility which could help bring the general cost down. An LUD would be available for the financing to homeowners which would be around \$27.00 a mo. along with the service provider fee which is running around \$50.00 a mo. right now.

2021 Keyport Rendezvous & Garage Sale – Patti C. – Provided feedback and thanks to all that helped that day. Great results for basically a ½ day sale due to inclement weather. The car show and music really brought more sales. It was suggested that coordination with the Keyport Bible Church be continued as before. If there is a 2022 sale, it will be held in June as in years prior.

Port of Keyport – Gene Warden – No firm schedule for the next phase but early Nov. is the start date. As more information becomes available, he will provide to us. The next phase of the project is putting the new float in for the boat ramp. The estimate for completion once started is 6 wks. and is required to be complete by the end of Jan. 2022. During construction the marina will be closed to the public and only tenants will have access.

Keyport Medical Supply - Rosie Watne reported that the supply in her garage has been very successful for people in the community.

New Business:

The board members will develop an annual budget to match what is needed for fundraising each year. Gene Warden and Jason Ward have volunteered to help with this.

Jason reported that the expense to the club for the annual pancake breakfast costs at least \$800.00 each yr. so we want to come up with ideas that are less work and more profitable.

Rosie Watne will also help the committee with goal setting and suggested a local garden tour as a fundraiser. Ideas are appreciated.
